On August 29, 2019, the U.S. Department of Education (Department), Office for Civil Rights (OCR), opened your complaint against The Washington University (University), St. Louis, Missouri, to investigate whether the University is violating Title VI, 34 C.F.R. § 100.3, by awarding student financial aid to students on the basis of race, either through the James E. McLeod Honors & Awards Program (McLeod Program), or other race-restricted financial aid programs.
